

ACTIVITIES

ADUANA – Be prepared to tell the customs official how long you plan to stay in Españolandia, whether you have family there, and 1-2 activities you plan to do during your stay.

BANCO - Exchange your U.S. money for pesos at the official exchange rate (1 peso = 10 cents). (Pesos can be exchanged back to US at any time.)

CAFE – Ask what kinds of drinks are available and ask how much one would cost. Buy a drink if you would like. (No purchase required.)

CASA DE MUSICA – Listen to/watch the videos to two or more songs. Tell the attendant which song you liked more and give several reasons why.

CORREO - Ask the price of postcards and buy one if you would like. Ask how much it would cost to send a card or letter to the U.S. (No purchase required.)

DULCERIA - Ask the price of something and then bargain for it. If you get a good price, buy it--it's authentic! (No purchase required.)

FARMACIA - Describe a symptom you or someone may have. Be prepared to answer related questions. Ask the pharmacist to recommend something to help.

This visa is issued under the following conditions:
