Standard Fees

Not included in annual cost example

-  Recreation Pass: \$82 per semester (refundable through 5th day of semester)
-  Athletic Fee: \$265 (one time fee)
-  Art & Design Technology Fee: \$250/semester (fee for MacBook, Art & Design students only)

Other Expenses

Families should also consider these additional expenses, which may vary by student:

-  Textbooks and supplies
-  Transportation and personal expenses
-  Parking pass (optional: \$140 per year)
-  Course/lab program fees (varies by course)
